In a career spanning decades and continents, Eyal Maoz stands as one of the most distinctive and adventurous guitar voices in contemporary jazz, avant-rock, and experimental music. A fixture of New York City's downtown scene, he bridges improvisation, composition, and genre-defying collaboration with rare originality and boldness. His music weaves intensity, melody, and imagination into something unmistakably his own.

At the heart of his work is Edom, Maoz's acclaimed ensemble that fuses progressive rock, jazz, and Middle Eastern influences into a sound both explosive and emotive. Its albums have earned international praise for their daring fusion of electric energy, improvisational depth, and lyrical expression.

Maoz has released albums on dik, Out Now, Feeding Tube, Piadrum, Ayler, Infrequent Seams, and Chant Records, and has performed with John Zorn's Abraxas and Cobra. His most recent duet album with Eugene Chadbourne drew wide critical acclaim, and his contribution to *Caught in the Rhythm* was a Grammy Nominated album. His composition “Boded” won the Orchestra of Our Time Open Score Project, recorded by the Scorchio Quartet. Featured on MTV and NPR, Maoz was invited to Italy to collaborate with poet Ronny Someck, to rave reviews.



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
